



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

ALANNA MOIR, #56,173
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“CARNA”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“DCRA”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **April 8, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, ALANNA MOIR, #56,173 (the “Regulated Member”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Regulated Member’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA and includes the following:

In December 2018, while working as a part-time staff nurse in a hospital setting, the Regulated Member diverted a syringe with one half milligram (0.5 mg) of a narcotic, falsified Pyxis records related to the wastage of a narcotic, and improperly disposed of the wastage without making personal use of its contents.

The Regulated Member agreed to provide a practice report letter from their employer and agreed to have restrictions on their permit for a period of eighteen (18) months. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Regulated Member’s practice permit.
