

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

TERRI-LYNN COCKBAIN, #82,338
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect August 27, 2026. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, TERRI-LYNN COCKBAIN, #82,338 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- On or about June 1, 2026, a Registrant displayed a lack of knowledge, skill or judgment in the provision of nursing services, when they:
 - Failed to administer appropriate medical care to a deteriorating patient; and
 - Failed to appropriately document patient care.

The Registrant agreed to coursework on critical thinking, and documentation and provide notification letters for a period of one year. The Registrant further agreed to employer references. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
