

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

LEDA JACKSON, #95,136
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect December 17, 2025. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, Leda Jackson, #95,136 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from two complaints to the College and includes the following:

- On or around October 5-9, 2023, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate nursing skill or judgment, to foster a therapeutic relationship with a resident or failed to act professionally when they:
 - Failed to properly advise resident of her mobility or lifting restrictions or to perform her duties in compliance with what was approved by her physician following a back injury.
- On or about November 1 and 4, 2023, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate nursing skill and/or judgment, when they:
 - Withdrew medications for a resident, including narcotics, from ward stock instead of using pre-packaged strips from the pharmacy, creating unnecessary wastage and risk of a medication error.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
