

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

PRECIOUS ALLI, #124,974
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect August 25, 2025. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, PRECIOUS ALLI, #124,974 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- The Registrant displayed a lack of knowledge, skill or judgment, when they:
 - Failed to check the telemetry lead correctly and in a timely manner, leading to a delay in staff recognizing a patient in cardiac arrest;
 - Administered IV medication to a patient when not authorized by employer to administer IV medication independently;
 - Failed to recognize that a patient under their care appeared to be in cardiac arrest;
 - Failed to assess sufficiently or at all a patient under their care who appeared to be in cardiac arrest;
 - Failed to press the staff alert button or call a code blue when a patient under their care appeared to be in cardiac arrest; or

- Failed to commence or assist their colleagues with interventions when a patient under their care was in cardiac arrest.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework on responsible nursing, health assessment and nursing process. The Registrant further agreed to employer references. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant's practice permit.
